Objective

- Provide IEEE 802 input into IEEE-SA engagements with ITU
- Receive updates on IEEE-SA engagements with ITU
- Do not interfere with existing technical liaisons to ITU-T (e.g., in 802.1, 802.3)
- Do not interfere with existing regulatory and technical liaisons with ITU-R (e.g., in 802.18)

IEEE and ITU

- IEEE is a Sector Member of ITU-T, ITU-R and ITU-D
 - Participate in the work of ITU-T Study Groups, Working Parties and expert groups, seminars, round tables, colloquia and workshops
 - Attend ITU and ITU-T decision-making bodies (e.g., ITU Plenipotentiary Conference, World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly)
 - ITU Council granted no fee sector membership ~2002
- IEEE is classified as a "regional or other international organization"
- IEEE is qualified as
 - <u>ITU-T A.6</u> Cooperation and exchange of information with national and regional SDOs
 - <u>ITU-T A.5</u> Making reference to documents from other organizations.

Res 81 – Strengthen Collab

- Define specific steps on how to improve coordination with other relevant standards bodies
- Rapporteur Group under TSAG
 - to examine existing methods and approaches to collaboration and/or cooperation with other standards organizations, with the view to encouraging ITU-T and other SDOs to work more collaboratively and/or cooperatively in a reciprocal manner based on mutual respect."

Res 82 - Review of ITU-T

- Examine the adequacy of the current structure of ITU-T
- Independent committee
 - expected to address
 coordination and
 collaboration from a
 "macro" perspective, by for
 example, studying the
 feasibility of developing
 MoUs between the ITU and
 other standards bodies.

ITU-T TSAG

- Meets yearly to deal with policy and governance issues for ITU-T and its study groups
 - Last meeting was February 2016 in Geneva.
 - Next meeting July 2016
- Topics of interest include
 - A-series improvements for collaboration
 - IPR policy
 - Study Group restructuring

TSAG Rapporteur Group on Strengthening Collaboration

- The goal is to improve the collaboration process with other SDOs such that it is simplified for ITU, but more importantly that it is mutually respectful.
- The focus is on a revision of the process documents: A.4, A.5 & A.6 The following is the new set:

Referencing	A.5-rev
Incorporation/Adoption	A.25
Joint work and/or collaboration	A.Supp.5

TSAG - July 2016 summary - 1

- Open source included in the "Living List" of items for further study such as the following:
 - What are the experiences of study groups and focus groups in ITU-T with open source? Is there a requirement of ITU-T study groups to collaborate with open source communities?
 - What are the possible relationships between ITU-T Recommendations and open source? What are the mechanisms to develop ITU-T Recommendations in collaboration with open source communities? How can open source foster implementation of ITU-T Recommendations?
 - What are the gaps with existing instruments, processes and procedures in ITU-T (for example, A-series Recommendations ITU-T A.5, A.25, Supplement 5, Joint Coordination Activities, Focus Groups, and Memoranda of Understanding) when applied to interaction with open source communities?

TSAG - July 2016 summary - 1

- No significant Study Group reorganization agreed
 - Several proposals to maintain SG15 but suppress SG11 and SG9
 - Security and Privacy
 - division of responsibility between Study Groups 17 and 20
 - Privacy separated from security, Given the policy issues associated with the issue of "privacy"
 - Benchmarking and Internet Speed Performance
 - SG12and 11 coordination
- A minor A.Supp.5 revision added multi-lateral coordination,
- New Strategic Standardization function
 - Will be led by industry, but no leader announced
- Resolutions proposals
 - Several suppression proposals

- Meets yearly to deal with policy and governance issues for ITU-T and its study groups
- Last meeting was July 2016 in Geneva
- General agreement to disband
